PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE



Bhaskar Degree College was established in the year 2009. It is being run under the aegis of Bhaskar Educational trust devoted to the promotion of general, professional and technical education. The college is recognized by the Govt. of J&K and is affiliated to the University of Jammu.

It is housed in a multi storied building comprising of 30 spacious Class-rooms, Audio-visual rooms, Seminar Hall, Administrative block, Computer labs, Geography labs, Music room, Multipurpose Hall, Psychology lab, Sports room, Examination Hall and well stocked reference library and reading room.

HIGHLIGHTS OF EVENTS

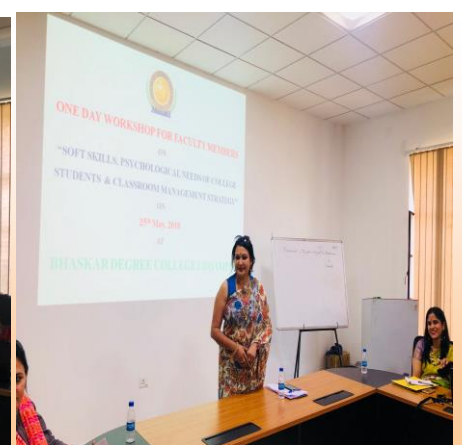
